

Poudre Valley Health System Foundation will have three refurbished defibrillators to give to a 501(c) 3 not-for profit, or a government entity with a not-for-profit status.

To be eligible to receive one, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Be an existing not-for-profit and provide a copy of your not-for-profit certificate. (pending not-for-profits will not be considered).
2. Completed application.
3. Be willing to receive training on use of the defibrillator by either PVHS Paramedic Services or proof of other training will be required.
4. Have a plan for battery changing/testing of the AED.
